



Experienced Hydrographic Surveyors

EGS Australia Pty Ltd are searching for experienced level 1 hydrographic surveyors to join the team. The successful candidate will be involved with both site and office work working on projects globally in both the inshore and offshore environment. The level 1 Surveyor is primarily responsible for the quality control in computation and logging of geospatial data and subsequent processing and reporting. As an experienced surveyor, you will be involved with all aspects of a project to include; tendering, survey planning, vessel mobilisation, equipment calibration/verification, survey acquisition, data QC, data processing, processing QC and final reporting. Working in small survey teams on complex projects, surveyors will be acquiring high quality bathymetric data and at times be involved in acquisition of other geophysical equipment (side scan sonar, sub-bottom profiler, magnetometer, multi-channel seismics, CPT, Vibrocore and grab sampling) and be working closely with the engineering department to assist in troubleshooting of any equipment related issues. Experience in online QC to ensure that the data is meeting client specifications is essential. Party Chief duties will be required on occasions.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

- A commitment to safe work practices and is willing to embrace the EGS Survey Management System and policies.
- Periodical appointments as Party Chief.
- Calibrating and operating positioning and attitude sensors for the real-time determination of positions for vessels and other survey platforms on or below the water line.
- Processing and reporting activities for the projects they undertake.
- Projects will vary between final position reports on a rig move to complex construction projects integrating data and information from a number of project vessel and construction phases.
- Project coordination to assist senior management.
- Be able to act as Emergency Control Team Information Coordinator.
- During an Incident or Near Miss:
 - Rectify Hazards (if safe and possible to do so).
 - Administer First Aid (if applicable).
 - Inform Party Chief/Senior Site Representative/Manager.
 - Initiate Emergency Response ((if applicable).
 - Be able to act as Incident Investigation Team Leader.

Authorities

- Instruct all EGS junior personnel in operations and Management System application.

- Sound experience in hydrographic surveying in support of the EGS business line.
- Demonstrate competence developing and maintaining sound co-worker relationships.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.

Requirements

- University degree in Hydrography or a closely related marine discipline.
- Certified with hydrographic commission panel of the Australia as level 1 surveyor

- Willing to relocate to EGS office in Perth, WA
- Site work rotations can be as short as a few days but also up to 6 weeks, therefore the ability to work away from home for long periods is essential.
